An Act to amend the act 2 George V, chapter 5, respecting subsidies to certain railway companies

[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 9 of the act 2 George V, chapter 5, as amended by the act 6 George V, chapter 6, section 1, is again amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

“The delay of four years, mentioned in this section 9, for the completion of the work, shall be five years for the part of Rivière Rouge railway from Huberdeau to the Canadian China Clay mines and from its immediate prolongation to the village of St. Rémi d'Amherst, county of Labelle.”
