An Act respecting the holding of the Superior Court and of the Circuit Court in and for the district of Quebec

[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

repealed. **1.** Article 3089*b* of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted by section 9 of the act 7 George V, chapter 14, is repealed.

am. **2.** Article 3090 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by the acts 5 George V, chapter 13, section 7, paragraph E, and 12 George V, chapter 21, section 9, paragraph B, is again amended by inserting therein, after the word: "Terrebonne", in the fourth line thereof, the word: "Quebec".

repealed. **3.** Article 3106 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted by section 10 of the act 7 George V, chapter 14, is repealed.

Suits, etc.,
continued,
etc. **4.** Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 1 and 3 of this act, all prosecutions, suits and proceedings begun before the Superior Court or Circuit Court of the district of Three Rivers, under articles 3089*b* and 3106 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, and the executions taken or to be taken out as a result of such prosecutions, suits or proceedings, or now pending as a result of judgments rendered by the Superior Court or Circuit Court of such district under such provisions, as well as all proceedings incidental or relating thereto, shall be continued, completed or taken as if this act had not been passed.

force. **5.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
