An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting
exhibitions of moving pictures

[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 3713^m of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as R. S., 3713^m
enacted by the act 3 George V, chapter 36, section 1, and ^{am.}
amended by the acts 4 George V, chapter 40, section 2,
and 11 George V, chapter 74, section 1, is again amended
by replacing the first six lines thereof by the following:

“**3713^m.** The commissioners and secretary shall receive such yearly remuneration as is fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, but not exceeding:

Yearly remuneration
of commis-
sioners and
secretary.

For the President.....	\$2,500.00
For a commissioner.....	1,500.00
For the secretary.....	600.00”

C H A P. 58

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting
the protection of public buildings against fire

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 3789^h of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as R. S., 3789^h,
enacted by the act 11 George V, chapter 75, section 2, is ^{am.}
amended by adding thereto, at the end of paragraph 1
thereof, the following paragraph:

“Such examiners shall receive a salary not exceeding,
for each one of them, one thousand dollars per annum.” <sup>Salary of
examiners.</sup>

enacted by the act 11 George V, chapter 75, section 2, is ^{am.}
amended by adding thereto, the following paragraph:
