CHAP. 89

An Act to amend the Municipal Code respecting expropriations for municipal purposes

[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Municipal Code is amended by inserting therein, after article 787 thereof, the following: Mun. Code, 787a, added.

“**787a.** Every municipal corporation may, for the purpose of supplying itself with the materials necessary for the building, maintaining and repairing of the roads under its control, expropriate, by complying with the provisions of this title: Expropriation and what is subject thereto.

1. Land containing sand, gravel or stone;
2. Temporary servitudes of right of way over land lying between the public road and the places where it is desired to take out the sand, stone and gravel.”

2. This act shall not affect pending cases.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

CHAP. 90

An Act to amend the charter of the city of Quebec

[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]

WHEREAS the city of Quebec has, by its petition, re-
