An Act to amend the charter of the town of La Tuque

[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]

WHEREAS the corporation of the town of La Tuque Preamble.

has represented by its petition that it is expedient, in the interest of the ratepayers and for the proper administration of the municipal business of the town of La Tuque, that its charter, the act 1 George V (2nd session), chapter 69, as amended by the acts 2 George V, chapter 70; 4 George V, chapter 86, and 11 George V, chapter 122, be again amended;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 3 of the act 4 George V, chapter 86, as re-4 Geo. V, c. placed by the act 11 George V, chapter 122, section 1, is 86, s. 3, repealed. repealed.

2. Article 5421 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as re-R. S., 5421, placed, for the town, by the act 4 George V, chapter 86, replaced for town. section 15, is again replaced, for the town, by the following:

"5421. The nomination of candidates at a general Nomination election shall be held on the 25th of June from noon to of candidates. two o'clock in the afternoon. If such day be a holiday, it shall be held on the first juridical day following such date, and during the same hours."

3. Section 10f of the act 1 George V (2nd session), 1 Geo. V chapter 69, as enacted by the act 11 George V, chapter (1911), c. 122, section 3, is amended by adding, after paragraph n, am. the following:

"o. The manager shall be a certificated civil engineer Qualifica- and a member of The Corporation of Professional Engin- tions. eers of Quebec;

"p. He may also exercise, with the approval of the coun- Additional cil, the duties of building and plumbing inspector, and ex- powers. ercise all other powers which the council may delegate to him by by-law or resolution."
