

Whereas it is expedient to grant his petition;

1. #### CHAP. 137

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons  
of the Province of Quebec to admit Jean Baptiste  
Delâge to the practice of medicine and surgery, after  
examination

[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]

**W**HEREAS Jean Baptiste Delâge, of the city and dis- <sup>Preamble.</sup>  
trict of Montreal, has, by his petition, represented:

That in the month of September, 1914, he was ad-  
mitted as a student of medicine and surgery in Laval  
University, of Montreal, and that he followed the lectures  
in medicine and surgery in the said university during the  
prescribed five years;

That in the month of June, 1919, the said university  
granted him a diploma of doctor of medicine;

That by inadvertence and for other grave reasons, he did  
not obtain from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of  
the Province of Quebec the certificate authorizing him to  
study medicine;

That from the year 1919, he has regularly and continuously  
acted as house doctor in different hospitals of Montreal;

That in view of the foregoing, the College of Physicians  
and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec has given its  
approval to the presenting of a bill authorizing the  
petitioner to practise medicine after having undergone the  
examination required for the license before the board of  
examiners of the said College;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be

passed to this effect, and whereas it is expedient to grant the said prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

J. B. Delâge admitted to practice of medicine, after examination. **1.** The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Jean Baptiste Delâge among its members, and to grant him the necessary license to practise medicine in the Province, after examination.

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

#### C H A P. 138

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Arthème Dutilly to the practice of medicine, surgery and obstetrics

*[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]*

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS Arthème Dutilly, physician and surgeon, of the city and district of Montreal, has, by his petition, represented:

That he obtained from the School of Medicine and Surgery of Laval University, Montreal, in July, 1920, a diploma of Doctor of Medicine, after having duly followed the course of studies in the said institution during the time prescribed by law;

That he began to follow the course of studies in the said institution before having obtained the permit to study medicine;

That he is duly qualified to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics;

That he is at present prohibited from obtaining his license to practice medicine, surgery and obstetrics, in the Province of Quebec, without special authorization from the Legislature;

That, in consequence, he is suffering a delay which is prejudicial;

That he obtained the consent of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, on the 26th day of September, 1922, to the passing of an act authorizing the said College to grant him the requisite license to practise his profession, after having passed the required examinations;
