1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Jean Baptiste Delâge among its members, and to grant him the necessary license to practise medicine in the Province, after examination.

CHAP. 138

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Arthème Dutilly to the practice of medicine, surgery and obstetrics

[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Arthème Dutilly, physician and surgeon, of the city and district of Montreal, has, by his petition, represented:

That he obtained from the School of Medicine and Surgery of Laval University, Montreal, in July, 1920, a diploma of Doctor of Medicine, after having duly followed the course of studies in the said institution during the time prescribed by law;

That he began to follow the course of studies in the said institution before having obtained the permit to study medicine;

That he is duly qualified to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics;

That he is at present prohibited from obtaining his license to practice medicine, surgery and obstetrics, in the Province of Quebec, without special authorization from the Legislature;

That, in consequence, he is suffering a delay which is prejudicial;

That he obtained the consent of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, on the 26th day of September, 1922, to the passing of an act authorizing the said College to grant him the requisite license to practise his profession, after having passed the required examinations;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Prov- Coll. of Phy.
ince of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Arthème and Surg.
Dutilly among its members, and to grant him the necessary ^{authorized} to admit A.

C H A P. 139

An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the
Province of Quebec to admit Georges Laurencelle
among its members

[Assented to, the 29th of December, 1922]

WHEREAS Georges Laurencelle, of the city of Lon- Preamble.
gueuil, in the district of Montreal, Doctor of Dental
Surgery, has, by his petition, represented:

That he was admitted to and attended a complete course
and clinical studies in dentistry in the School of Dental
Surgery of Laval University, Montreal, where he graduated
after the regular examination and received the diploma of
Doctor of Dental Surgery on the 1st of May, 1920;

That, through his studies and experience, he acquired
the knowledge required for becoming a practitioner of
dental surgery and the skill necessary for the practice of
such profession;

That, in the month of May, 1914, he successfully under-
went the examination in Sciences for admission to the
study of his profession and passed all the subjects in
Letters, except Latin;

That he intended to resume that portion of his examina-
tion for admission to the study of his profession, but was
prevented from so doing when the European War broke
out and he voluntarily enlisted in the Canadian Army in
the month of September, 1915;

That since he obtained the Diploma of Doctor in Dental
Surgery, he was prevented from undergoing the examina-
