

## C H A P. 4

An Act to authorize a grant for purposes of education to  
the University of Bishop's College

[Assented to, 21st of March, 1922]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council is authorized <sup>Grant to</sup> to grant to the University of Bishop's College a sum of <sup>Bishop's</sup> not more than one hundred thousand dollars, payable, <sup>College.</sup> in annual instalments of twenty thousand dollars each, out of the consolidated revenue fund.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming</sup> sanction. <sup>into force.</sup>

## C H A P. 5

An Act to authorize the granting of subsidies to classical  
colleges, and to certain other schools.

[Assented to, 8th of March, 1922]

**W**HEREAS for over two centuries the classical colleges <sup>Preamble.</sup> have rendered undeniable services to the population of Canada;

Whereas, heretofore, they have borne almost alone the costs of secondary instruction, which has benefited thousands of citizens of this Province and of the entire continent;

Whereas, since their foundation, they have annually given free tuition to numerous young persons;

Whereas, it is in the interest of the Province that secondary instruction should continue to progress;

Whereas, in order to better attain this object, it is urgent to put at the disposal of classical colleges subsidies enabling them to effect the progress and improvement which they desire, and, especially, to send to the superior normal schools of Quebec, Montreal or elsewhere, pupils or professors destined for the teaching of secondary instruction;

And Whereas, it is likewise expedient to aid certain Protestant schools;
