

C H A P. 27

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting the Quebec Public Service Commission.

[Assented to, the 8th of March, 1922]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 740 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted R. S., 740, by the act 10 George V, chapter 21, section 1, and amended ^{am.} by the acts 11 George V, chapter 22, section 2, and 12 George V, chapter 28, section 1, is again amended by replacing paragraph *k* thereof, by the following:

"*k.* notwithstanding any provision in the charter of either of such cities respectively,—on any question arising ^{Expropriation by} respecting expropriation by the city of Quebec or by the ^{cities of} city of Montreal for any municipal purpose (including the ^{Quebec and} fixing of the compensation), which, under the said charters, is within the jurisdiction of any board of commissioners, commissioner, assessor, arbitrator or other functionary or officer; provided that every provision relating to expropriation in either of the said charters shall continue to govern expropriations by each of such cities respectively, with the exception of the modification introduced by this paragraph."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}

C H A P. 28

An Act to amend the act respecting the Quebec Public Service Commission.

[Assented to, the 21st of March, 1922]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 740 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted R. S., 740, by the act 10 George V, chapter 21, section 1, and as ^{am.} amended by the acts 11 George V, chapter 22, section 2, and 12 George V, chapter 27, section 1, is again amended by adding thereto, after paragraph *k* thereof, the following:
