

C H A P. 38

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, relating to improvement in the breeding of horses

[Assented to, the 8th of March, 1922]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1773c of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as R. S., 1773c, enacted by the act 9 George V, chapter 27, section 1, ^{am.} is amended by replacing the word: "May", in the third line thereof, by the word: "February".

2. Article 1773g of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as Id., 1773g, enacted by the act 9 George V, chapter 27, section 1, is ^{am.} amended by replacing in the fourth line thereof, the words: "of two dollars", by the words: "the amount of which shall be determined by the Inspection Board, but must not exceed ten dollars per stallion."

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. _{force.}

C H A P. 39

An Act concerning certain loans by agricultural societies

[Assented to, the 21st of March, 1922]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1797 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amend- R. S., 1797, ed by adding thereto, after the second paragraph thereof, ^{am.} the following paragraph:

"The society may, with the approval of the Minister of ^{Loans by} Agriculture, contract loans, by notes or otherwise, and ^{the society.} hypothecate its immoveable property, as security for the repayment, provided that the total amount of such loans ^{Amount.} shall not exceed, at any time, the sum of seven thousand dollars."

2. The loans made by agricultural societies, by notes ^{Certain}

loans validated. or otherwise, before the date of the coming into force of this act, are validated insofar as the borrowing power of such societies is concerned.

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P. 40

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting agricultural societies

[Assented to, the 8th of March, 1922]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., 1832, replaced. **1.** Article 1832 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is replaced by the following:

No salaries etc. **“1832.** No portion of the moneys belonging to such a society shall be employed in the payment of any salary or allowance, but the secretary-treasurer may be allowed a sum not exceeding ten per cent of the net receipts, provided that such sum does not exceed five hundred dollars, in the place and stead of any salary, in conformity with the by-laws that may be adopted from time to time by the Council of Agriculture.

Allowance to secretary-treasurer. **Proviso.** The special grants shall not be taken into account in the calculation of net receipts.

Calculation of net receipts. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P. 41

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting farmers' clubs
