## C H A P. 62

An Act to amend the act respecting the Court of the Sessions of the Peace

[Assented to, 21st of March, 1922]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., 3262, replaced.

**1.** Article 3262 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by the acts 4 George V, chapter 36, section 1, and 5 George V, chapter 52, section 2, is replaced by the following:

Salaries of judges of the sessions.

**"3262.** The annual salary of each of the judges of the sessions, ordinarily discharging the duties of such office, shall not exceed six thousand dollars, and the salary, so fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, shall be payable out of the consolidated revenue fund of the Province; and each such judge shall perform the duties of judge of the sessions and license commissioner, as well as all other duties incumbent upon him, or which may be imposed upon him by any law in force in this Province."

Duties.

Coming into force.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
