

## C H A P. 72

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting  
hotels and lodging-houses

[Assented to, the 8th of March, 1922]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Revised Statutes, 1909, are amended by inserting R. S., 3866cc, therein, after article 3866c, as enacted by the act 4 George V, chapter 41, section 1, the following:

**"3866cc.** Every person being the proprietor, lessee or Obligation manager of a hotel or lodging-house shall post up, and of prop-

**2.** Article 3866d of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as R. S., 3866d, enacted by the act 4 George V, chapter 41, section 1, and am.  
amended by the act 10 George V, chapter 55, section 3, is  
again amended by inserting therein, after the first para-  
graph thereof, the following:

"The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may likewise and Carrying  
in the same manner enact such provisions as he may deem out of pro-  
expedient with respect to the carrying out of the provi- visions.  
sions of article 3856cc."

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into  
sanction. force.
