

## C H A P. 72

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting  
hotels and lodging-houses

[Assented to, the 8th of March, 1922]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Revised Statutes, 1909, are amended by inserting R. S., 3866cc, therein, after article 3866c, as enacted by the act 4 George V, chapter 41, section 1, the following:

“**3866cc.** Every person being the proprietor, lessee or manager of a hotel or lodging-house shall post up, and keep continuously so posted, in a conspicuous place in the office, the dining-room and each of the bed-rooms of the hotel or lodging-house, a placard indicating, in the French and English languages, the rental charge of each of the bed-rooms, with or without meals, and the price charged for breakfast, dinner and supper or for all three meals taken otherwise than *à la carte*.”

**2.** Article 3866d of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted by the act 4 George V, chapter 41, section 1, and amended by the act 10 George V, chapter 55, section 3, is again amended by inserting therein, after the first paragraph thereof, the following:

“The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may likewise and in the same manner enact such provisions as he may deem expedient with respect to the carrying out of the provisions of article 3856cc.”

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
