## C H A P. 79

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting  
civil engineers

*Assented to, 21st of March, 1922]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 5116 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amend-<sup>R. S., 5116,</sup> ed by the act 10 George V, chapter 66, section 1, is again<sup>am.</sup> amended by replacing paragraph *c* thereof, by the following:

“*c.* The expression “member” means a member of the “Member.” said corporation.”

**2.** Article 5116<sup>b</sup> of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as<sup>R.S., 5116b,</sup> enacted by the act 10 George V, chapter 66, section 2, is<sup>am.</sup> amended by replacing the words: “of the Engineering Institute of Canada, domiciled outside of the Province of Quebec,” in the eighth, ninth, and tenth lines of paragraph 2 thereof, by the following: “of any corporation or society of professional engineers of the other Provinces of Canada, provided such corporation or society exacts equivalent qualifications for the admission of its members and that it grants the same privileges to members of the corporation of this Province.”

**3.** Article 5117 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amend-<sup>Id., 5117,</sup> ed by the act 10 George V, chapter 66, section 3, is again<sup>am.</sup> amended by striking out paragraphs *b* and *c* thereof.

**4.** Article 5118 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amend-<sup>Id., 5118,</sup> ed by the act 10 George V, chapter 66, section 4, is again<sup>am.</sup> amended:

*a.* By replacing the first paragraph thereof, by the following:

**"5118.** The following are members of the corporation:";

*b.* By inserting therein, after paragraph *b*, the following:

*"ba.* All persons having the right to use the title of Civil Engineer under an act of the Province of Quebec;"

*c.* By inserting therein, after paragraph *c*, the following:

*"ca.* The engineers, who, on the 31st of December, 1917, were active members of any recognized society of civil engineers and who resided and exercised their profession in the Province of Quebec during the four years preceding such date, provided that they have their names and addresses entered in the registers of the corporation before the 1st of March, 1924;"

enacted.

**5.** The following articles are inserted in the Revised Statutes, 1909, after article 5118 as amended by the act 10 George V, chapter 66, section 4:

**"5118a.** The Council shall admit as a member of the corporation any person domiciled in the Province, who holds a diploma of civil engineering or the degree of Bachelor of Applied Science from the Polytechnic School of Montreal or the Faculty of Applied Science of McGill University, obtained after the 1st of March, 1922, provided that such person has been registered as a student member of the corporation during four years. The four years of clerkship required will not apply to students who are registered in the above-mentioned school and university on the 1st of March, 1922.

**"5118b.** The Council may, in its discretion, upon a report made by the examiners of the corporation to the effect that the candidate possesses the required knowledge, capacity and qualifications, admit as a member of the corporation any person residing in the Province and holding a diploma of civil engineering or the degree of Bachelor of Applied Science from any recognized school or university, or any member of other engineering societies or corporations of professional engineers of like importance, upon presentation of his credentials, and provided he pay the requisite fee for admission to practice.

**"5118c.** The Council shall have the power to grant to any engineer, residing out of the Province of Quebec and being the holder of a diploma of civil engineering or of the degree of Bachelor of Applied Science from any school or university, recognized by the Council, or a member of other engineering societies or corporations of

engineers likewise recognized by the Council, a temporary license to practise, upon payment of the fees provided for by the by-laws, on condition that the actual engineering work planned be carried out in collaboration with an engineer, member in good standing of the corporation."

**6.** Article 5119 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended R. S., 5119, ed by replacing the words: "Laval University", in the <sup>am.</sup> fifth and sixth lines of the second paragraph thereof, by the words: "the Polytechnic School."

**7.** Article 5120 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended R. S., 5120, ed by the act 10 George V, chapter 66, section 5, is again <sup>am.</sup> amended:

*a.* By inserting therein, after the words: "following subjects, namely:" in the first line of sub-paragraph *c* of paragraph 1 thereof, the words: "grammar and composition, in either English or French;";

*b.* By replacing paragraph 4 thereof, by the following:

"4. If the candidate holds a degree of Bachelor of Applied Science, Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Sciences, or Bachelor of Letters, conferred upon him by a university recognized by the Council, or has graduated from and holds the diploma of the Royal Military College, or proves, to the satisfaction of the Council, that he has passed the examinations for admission to study in an engineering school or university, recognized by the Council, or holds a diploma as Provincial land surveyor in this Province, he shall, on making satisfactory proof that he is the person named in such degree or diploma, be entitled, on payment of the above mentioned fee, to receive a certificate permitting him to study."

Holders of certain degrees, entitled to admission to study.

*c.* By adding thereto the following paragraphs:

"5. The student members of the Engineering Institute of Canada, domiciled in the Province on the 1st of March 1922, shall be entitled to a certificate of admission to study, counting from the date of their admission in the Engineering Institute of Canada, providing they make application therefor before the 1st of March 1923."

Idem, for certain student members of Engineering Institute of Canada, on certain conditions.

"6. Every student must perform the clerkship exacted by the provisions of this section, under indentures entered into with an engineer member of the corporation, which indentures shall be passed before a notary, as well as any transfer that may be made thereof, and an authentic copy of same must be deposited with the registrar. The period of clerkship shall count only from the date of registration with the registrar of the corporation."

R. S., 5121, am. **8.** Article 5121 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by the act 10 George V, chapter 66, section 6, is again amended:

*a.* By striking out all the words of sub-paragraph *d* of paragraph 1 which follow the word: "surveyor" in the fifth line thereof;

*b.* By inserting therein, after paragraph 2, the following paragraph:

Admission as corporate members of certain persons after examination.

"*2a.* The junior members of the Engineering Institute of Canada, domiciled in the Province on the 1st of April 1922, may, in the discretion of the Council, be admitted as members of the corporation after having taken the examination for admission to practice, providing they have their names and addresses entered in the registers of the corporation before the 1st of March 1923."

R. S., 5125, am. **9.** Article 5125 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as replaced by the act 8 George V, chapter 57, section 1, is amended:

*a.* By replacing the first three lines of the first paragraph thereof, by the following lines:

Practising as civil engineer without right.

"**5125.** Any person, not being a member in good standing of the Corporation of Professional Engineers of the Province of Quebec, who:";

*b.* By striking out, in the fifth line of paragraph *c* thereof, the words: "of civil engineers";

*c.* By striking out the last paragraph thereof.

## C H A P. 80

An Act respecting municipal affairs, and to amend accordingly the Revised Statutes, 1909, the Revised Statutes, 1888, and the Municipal Code
