

C H A P. 81

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting
the annexation of territories, forming part of a city
city or town, to another corporation

[Assented to, 21st of March, 1922]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The following section and article, are inserted in R. S., 5886a,
the Revised Statutes, 1909, after section second of chapter enacted.
second of title eleventh:

“SECTION 11a

“ANNEXATION OF A TERRITORY, BELONGING TO A CITY OR
TOWN, TO ANOTHER CORPORATION

“**5886a.** The council of a municipality governed by Annexation
the Municipal Code may, by the affirmative vote of the of a territory
absolute majority of its members, pass by-laws for extending belonging to
the limits of the municipality by annexing thereto, for a city or
municipal purposes, any contiguous part of a city or town. town to an-
other cor-

The formalities to be observed are those prescribed by Provisions
articles 5286 and following, *mutatis mutandis*, (Cities and applicable.
Towns' Act), but the by-law submitted to the city or town Proviso,
municipality, for approval, by the council of the municipi-
pality asking for the annexation, must be unanimously
approved by the council of the city or town before being
submitted to the electors.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
