An Act to incorporate the town of Baie St. Paul as a village

[Assented to, 8th of March, 1922]

WHEREAS the corporation of the town of Baie St. Paul erected as a town municipality under letters patent issued on the 7th August 1913, under the authority of the Cities and Towns' Act has, by its petition represented, that in view of the decrease of the population and the disappearance of industries in the municipality it is expedient that it be constituted a village municipality for municipal and school purposes; Preamble.

Whereas its petition contains a demand to that effect and it is expedient to grant the same;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The letters patent issued on the 7th August 1913, constituting as a town municipality the municipality of the village of Baie St. Paul, under the authority of the Cities and Towns' Act, are annulled except in so far as concerns the limits of the said municipality which are retained for the municipality of the village of Baie St. Paul. Letters patent annulled. Except.

2. The act 7 George V, chapter 76, intituled "An Act respecting the town of Baie St. Paul" which divided the said municipality, into three wards is repealed. 7 Geo. V, c. 76, repealed.

The constitution of the village

3. The said municipality shall be a village municipality bearing the name of "The municipality of the village of Baie St. Paul"; Village municipality. Name.

4. The inhabitants comprised within the limits of the municipality of the village of Baie St. Paul shall form a corporation under the name of "The Corporation of the Village of Baie St. Paul". Corporation constituted. Name.

Transitory Provisions

5. Except where the same may be inconsistent with this act, all by-laws, *procès-verbaux*, resolutions, orders, lists, va- By-laws, etc., to

remain in force. valuation rolls, assessment rolls, ordinances, decisions, contracts, debentures, bonds, accounts of dues, rights and other matters or things done by the corporation of the town of Baie St. Paul shall remain in force in and for the village of Baie St. Paul until the same are repealed, replaced or amended by the corporation.

Continuing in office. **6.** The mayor and councillors of the town of Baie St. Paul shall remain in office and act as mayor and councillors of the village of Baie St. Paul until their successors are chosen at the general elections; the presentation of candidates for such general elections shall be on the second Wednesday of the month of January in the year 1923, and the said general elections and future elections shall take place in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Code.

Idem. **7.** The municipal officers of the town of Baie St. Paul shall continue to perform their respective duties throughout the whole village as municipal officers of the village of Baie St. Paul until they are replaced in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Code.

Succeeds to rights and obligations. **8.** The corporation of the village of Baie St. Paul shall succeed to all the rights and obligations of the corporation of the town of Baie St. Paul.

Mun. Code to govern. **9.** The municipality of the village of Baie St. Paul shall be governed by the Municipal Code of the Province of Quebec.

Coming into force. **10.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction

An Act to amend the charter of the Roberval and Saguenay Railway Company
