7. Article 2 of schedule C of the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 121, respecting *la Caisse de Remboursement*, as replaced by the act 10 George V, chapter 130, section 5, is again replaced by the following:

“Art. 2. *La Caisse*, may, for such remuneration or consideration as may be agreed upon between it and the members of *La Société Saint-Jean-Baptiste de Montréal (Caisse Nationale d'Economie)*, guarantee to the heirs or assigns of the latter, in the case of death, the repayment with or without interest, of the amounts paid by them as members of *La Caisse Nationale d'Economie* and as members of *La Caisse de Remboursement*, and the payment of any balance of pension or of its equivalent, payable by *La Caisse Nationale d'Economie* to such members or to their heirs or assigns, under the certificates held by all such members.

In the event of a deceased member not having designated the person authorized to receive such reimbursement, the latter shall be given to one of the heirs mentioned below, and in the following order: to the surviving consort, to the oldest of the children of full age, to the tutor of the children, to the father, mother, oldest brother, oldest sister, or, in the event of there being no such heir, then to any other surviving heir. The payment made in the manner set forth in this article shall free *la Caisse* but shall not affect the rights of the heirs among themselves.

In the event of members being minors, the person applying for their inscription and paying contributions for them, is authorized to sign the declaration of appropriation of the benefits, and to make such benefits payable to himself or to any other person whom he designates.”

CHAP. 131

An Act to amend the act 10 George V, chapter 141,
respecting the Association of Registered Nurses of the
Province of Quebec

[Assented to, 21st of March, 1922]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Misses Rachel Rainville, Elizabeth Fleurant, and Theophita Marier, all three nurses practising in the city and district of Montreal, have, by their petition represented, that it is expedient to amend the

act 10 George V, chapter 141, incorporating the Association of Registered Nurses of the Province of Quebec, in order to enable certain nurses holding diplomas and practising in the Province of Quebec, when the said act was passed, as well as other persons, to form part of the association on certain conditions; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 5 of the act 10 George V, chapter 141, is replaced by the following: 10 Geo. V,
c. 141, s. 5,
replaced.

"5. The provisional committee of management of the association shall: Duties of
provisional
committee.

a. open the register of members of the association and inscribe therein all those who are entitled to become members thereof without examination under section 8 of the act 10 George V, chapter 141, and under sections 8a and 8b of the said act as enacted by the act 12 George V, chapter 131, section 2, and who make the application and comply with the other formalities prescribed by one or other of these sections, as the case may be;

b. call the first meeting of the members of the association at such time and place, and in such manner as they may determine, in the city of Montreal, within three months from the date of the passing of this act;

c. do all other things within the powers of the committee of management of the association that it may be necessary to do in the interest of the association previous to the holding of the first meeting of the members thereof."

2. The following sections are added after section 8 of the act 10 George V, chapter 141: 10 Geo. V,
c. 141, ss. 8a
and 8b,
enacted.

"8a. All persons shall have the right to become members of the association, without examination and on payment of the entrance fee, who practise as nurses in the Province of Quebec and who hold, when the present act is passed, a certificate or diploma from a training school in connection with special hospitals or a general hospital in the Province, authorized to give such certificates or diplomas, and all persons who, at the passing of this act, have commenced their studies in similar training schools connected with special hospitals or general hospitals in the Province, authorized as above to deliver such certificate or diplomas and who obtain from such schools the diploma or certificate as nurse, provided that in the first Those

case the course in such schools be of at least two years and in the second case at least three years.

"**8b.** Nurses who are holders of diplomas from a University of the Province, after having followed a course of at least three years in a nurses' school, recognized by the Faculty of Medicine of such University, shall be registered without further examination, on payment of the entrance fee."

3. Section 23 of the act 10 George V, chapter 141, is replaced by the following:

"**23.** The decision of the committee of management, as to admission of members, the report of either board of examiners, when an examination is required, or as to censure, suspension or expulsion of members, shall be final and without appeal, and the said committee shall be the sole judge of the qualifications of applicants for membership and of the conduct and competency of members whose censure, suspension or expulsion is decided on.

No refusal
for want of
capability.

Nothing contained in this section can be interpreted as giving the right to the committee of management to refuse, for want of capability, the persons who are entitled to be admitted under section 8 of the act 10 George V, chapter 141, and under sections 8a and 8b of the said act as enacted by section 2 of the act 12 George V, chapter 131.

An Act to incorporate *La Société des Missions Etrangères de la Province de Québec*
