

credit of the Province, by virtue of any general or special authorization, shall have the right to obtain the registration as to principal of such bond or debenture in his name by the Provincial Treasurer, upon such terms and conditions as the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may be pleased to fix.

2. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may make the necessary regulations for carrying out the provisions of section 1, providing, amongst other things, for the fees to be paid and the formalities to be required for each registration and for each transfer of any such bond or debenture.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 5

An Act to amend the act 9 George V, chapter 4, respecting the Sanatorium at Ste. Agathe des Monts

[Assented to, 25th of February, 1921]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 4 of the act 9-George V, chapter 4, is amended by replacing the words: "one hundred and fifty thousand", in the eighth and ninth lines thereof, by the words: "one hundred and eighty thousand".

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 6

An Act to authorize the purchase of the Lake Edward Sanatorium

[Assented to, 19th of March, 1921]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council is authorized

ization to purchase Lake Edward Sanatorium. to enter into a contract for the purchase of the Lake Edward Sanatorium, from the Lake Edward Sanatorium Association, a body politic and corporate, duly incorporated, for a sum of not more than sixty thousand dollars, payable in such amounts and at such dates as may be agreed upon between the parties.

Payment out of consol. revenue fund. **2.** The Provincial Treasurer is authorized to make, out of the consolidated revenue fund, all payments arranged for as mentioned in section 1.

Authorization for agreement as to operation of sanatorium. **3.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may enter into an agreement with any person, corporation or association for the operation and management of the said sanatorium, as well as for the keeping, maintenance, support and treatment of sick persons therein.

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 7

An Act to amend the act 2 George V, chapter 2, providing for the abolition of toll bridges and turnpike roads in the Province

[Assented to, 25th of February, 1921]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

2 Geo. V, c. 2, s. 2, am. **1.** Section 2 of the act 2 George V, chapter 2, as amended by the act 7 George V, chapter 6, section 1, is again amended:

a. by replacing the word: "eight", in the first line thereof, by the word: "fifteen";

b. by replacing the word: "five", in the third line thereof, by the word: "seven".

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
