An Act respecting the Sherbrooke Technical School

[Assented to, 19th of March, 1921]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 9 of the act 9 George V, chapter 40, is 9 Geo. V, c. 40, s. 9, am. amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

"Notwithstanding the provisions of by-law No. 408, Authoriza- tion to city of Sherbrooke to vary enacting that the sum of thirty thousand dollars mentioned in the said by-law shall be appropriated for the acquisition of Sherbrooke to vary by the city of a certain lot therein designated, for the construction of the Sherbrooke Technical School, the appropriation of cer- tain money corporation of the city of Sherbrooke is authorized to voted. hand over such sum of thirty thousand dollars to the corporation of the Sherbrooke Technical School, to be used by the latter for the purchase of a lot chosen by itself, within the boundaries of the said city, for the building of the said school."

2. Section 11 of the act 9 George V, chapter 40, is Id., s. 11, am. amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

"The corporation is likewise authorized to receive from Corpora- tion autho- rized to re- ceive and employ cer- tain money. the city of Sherbrooke, and to employ in the acquisition of a lot to be chosen by itself, provided it be situated within the boundaries of the city, and in the construction employ cer- tain money. thereon of a building or buildings for the technical school, any sum appropriated by the said city for that purpose."

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into force. sanction.
