

## C H A P. 63

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting  
the district magistrate's court

[Assented to, 19th of March, 1921]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 3293 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is re-  
placed by the following: R. S., 3293,  
replaced.

**"3293.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may <sup>Magistrate's</sup> establish one or more Magistrate's Courts in that part of <sup>Courts in</sup> the county of Saguenay situated to the west of the Jeremy <sup>the district</sup> Islands exclusively, with such territorial jurisdiction as he <sup>of Saguenay.</sup> may deem expedient to assign to each. Such courts shall be designated in the manner indicated in article 3292.

He may also establish as many additional Magistrate's  
Courts as he may deem expedient, in the other parts of  
the county of Saguenay."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming  
into force.

## C H A P. 64

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting  
the salary of district magistrates

[Assented to, 19th of March, 1921]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 3300 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is R. S., 3300,  
amended by replacing the word: "three", in the fourth <sup>am.</sup>  
line thereof, by the word: "four".

**2.** This act shall come into force upon the date fixed by Coming  
into force.
