An Act to legalize certain entries in the register of notices
in use in the registry office of the registration division
of Levis

[Assented to, 25th of February, 1921]

WHEREAS the registrar of the registration division of Preamble.

Levis has omitted to gave paged, paraphed and attested, as required by articles 2181 and 2182 of the Civil Code, by the prothonotary of the Superior Court, for the district of Quebec, the register in which are registered the notices of judgment and the notices mentioned in paragraph 5 of article 2161 of the Civil Code ;

Whereas the register of notices of the registration division of Levis has been paged, paraphed and attested by the said prothonotary on the 25th of May, 1920 ;

Whereas it is necessary to legalize the entries made in the said register of notices from the date when it was first made use of up to the 25th of May, 1920, inclusive, the date when the formalities required by articles 2181 and 2182 of the Civil Code were carried out ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Every entry made in the register of notices of judgment and of notices required by paragraph 5 of article 2161 of the Civil Code, in use in the registry office of the registration division of Levis, up to the 25th of May, 1920, inclusive, are and shall be as valid as if such register had been, before being used, paged, paraphed and attested by the prothonotary of the Superior Court for the district of Quebec. Certain entries validated.

2. Nothing in this act shall affect any pending case in which the validity of any registration is at issue. Pending cases.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
