That he did not complete until the 29th of September, 1920, his examination for admission to the study of dental surgery, but was regularly admitted at that date;

That, owing to said delay in admission to study, he will be prevented from being examined by the Board of Governors of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec for the practice of dentistry;

That the Board of Governors of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec has given its approval to the passing of an act authorizing the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit the said Eddie Lamontagne amongst its members and to authorize him to practise the profession of dentistry, after a final examination for the practice of that profession; and

Whereas he has, by his petition, prayed that an act be passed to that effect, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to admit the said Eddie Lamontagne amongst its members and to grant him the necessary license to practise the profession of dentist in this Province, after a final examination for admission to the practice of that profession.

CHAP. 187

An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Léon Leduc to the practice of dentistry

[Assented to, 25th of February, 1921]

WHEREAS Léon Leduc, of the city and district of Montreal, Doctor of Dental Surgery, has, by his petition, represented:

Preamble.

That he was admitted to and followed a complete course and clinical studies in dentistry in the School of Dental Surgery, of Laval University, Montreal, where he graduated after the regular examination and received the diploma of Doctor of Dental Surgery on the 3rd of May, 1918;

That, through his duties and experience, he acquired the knowledge and title required for becoming a practician of dental surgery and the skill necessary for the practice of such profession;

That, after obtaining the diploma of Doctor of Dental Surgery, he was prevented from undergoing the examination before the Board of Governors of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, for the practice of the dental profession, because he did not complete his examination for the admission to study the profession until the 7th of April, 1920, but was regularly admitted on that date, having previously graduated and obtained the diploma of Doctor of Dental Surgery as aforesaid;

That the Board of Governors of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec has consented to the passing of an act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit the said Léon Leduc among its members and to authorize him to practise the profession of dentist, after the final examination for the practice of such profession;

And whereas he has, by his petition, prayed that an act be passed to that effect, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:
