An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting
colonization roads

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., 2064, replaced. **1.** Article 2064 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is replaced
by the following:

An Act to amend the Quebec Mining Law

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., 2103, am. **1.** Article 2103 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amend-
ed by the act 4 George V, chapter 20, section 2, is again
amended:

a. by replacing the words: “before the mining rights are
affected by a claim, a mining license or a mining conces-
sion”, in the sixth line thereof, by the words: “before the
first of January, 1921”;

b. by adding thereto, at the end of the first paragraph
thereof, the words: “After the 31st of December, 1920, all
mines shall belong to the Crown under the soil of land
