

which, on the 24th of July, 1880, had not yet been patented”.

2. Article 2121*a* of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as ^{Id., 2121*a*, am.} enacted by the act 1 George V (2nd session), chapter 23, section 4, and amended by the act 4 George V, chapter 20, section 4, is again amended:

a. by inserting therein, after the word: “Law”, in the third line thereof, the words: “and which had not been patented on the expiration of the delay of two years mentioned in article 2121,”;

b. by inserting therein, after the word: “and” in the third line thereof, the word: “those”.

3. Article 2131 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amend- ^{Id., 2131, am.} ed by the acts 1 George V (1st session), chapter 17, section 11, and 1 George V (2nd session), chapter 23, section 5, is again amended by adding thereto, at the end of the first paragraph thereof, the words: “The delay shall not run during the months of January, February and March.”.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into force.} sanction.

CHAP. 30

An Act to amend the Quebec Fisheries' Act

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The following article is inserted in the Revised ^{R. S., 2286*a*, enacted.} Statutes, 1909, after article 2286 thereof:

“2286*a*. Any person who is disguised or masked and ^{Penalty.} at the same time in possession of any fishing tackle and about to commit any offence against this section, shall be liable to imprisonment for a term of not more than three months without the option of a fine, in addition to any other penalty provided for such offence.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into force.} sanction.
