

## C H A P. 54

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting  
the protection of public buildings against fire

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The following article is inserted in the Revised Statutes, 1909, after article 3781*b* thereof, as enacted by the act 8 George V, chapter 51, section 1:

“**3781bb.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may appoint two or more examiners, with special technical knowledge of electricity, whose duty it shall be to test the qualifications of applicants for the license mentioned in article 3781*b*, at a salary of not more than one thousand dollars per annum for each.

The salary of such officers, and the expenses incurred for the carrying out of this subsection 6*a*, shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund.”

## C H A P. 55

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting  
the inspection of hotels, restaurants and lodging-  
houses

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 3866*a* of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted by the act 4 George V, chapter 41, section 1, is amended:

*a.* by replacing the words: “or boarding houses”, in the second line thereof, by the words: “restaurants or lodging-houses”;
