

## "SECTION IIIA

## "MUNICIPAL LOAN BY-LAWS

Approval by Lt-Gov. in C. "5888a. Any provision in any special act to the contrary notwithstanding, every municipal by-law ordering or authorizing a loan must, in order to have any force or effect, and to come into force, be approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

This article shall not apply to the cities of Quebec and Montreal.

Special tax for creating sinking-fund. "5888b. Any provision in any special act to the contrary notwithstanding, any municipal corporation which has contracted a loan by an issue of bonds or debentures, without the by-law authorizing such loan making provision for the collection of a sinking-fund, may, by by-law, impose a special tax for the purpose of creating a sinking-fund to repay the said loan at maturity.

Approval by Lt-Gov. in C. No by-law passed under this article shall be submitted to the approval of the electors, but must be approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

Deposit of sinking-fund with Prov. Treas. The sinking-fund collected under any by-law passed under the authority of this article, must be deposited in the office of the Provincial Treasurer in conformity with the provisions of section XXIVA of chapter fifth of title fourth of these Revised Statutes (articles 1493a to 1493h)."

## C H A P. 68

An Act to amend article 5726 of the Revised Statutes, 1909 respecting the interest payable on arrears of municipal taxes in cities and towns

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

R. S. 5726, am. 1. Article 5726 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended

by replacing the word: "five", in the first line thereof, by the word: "six".

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## C H A P. 69

An Act to amend article 5814 of the Revised Statutes,  
1909, relating to the appointment of recorders

*[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 5814 of the Revised Statutes 1909,, is amend-<sup>R. S., 5814,</sup> ed by striking out all the words after the words: "Lieute-<sup>am.</sup>nant-Governor in Council", in the first and second lines thereof, to the end of the article.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanc-<sup>Coming</sup> tion. <sub>into force.</sub>

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## C H A P. 70

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting  
the jurisdiction of recorders' courts in certain cases

*[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Chapter second of title eleventh of the Revised Stat-<sup>R. S.,</sup> utes, 1909, is amended by inserting therein, after article <sup>section and</sup> 5952 thereof, the following section and articles: <sub>articles,</sub> <sub>enacted.</sub>

"SECTION XXIIA

"JURISDICTION OF RECORDERS' COURTS IN CERTAIN CASES
