## CHAP. 76

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting  
conciliation

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Subsection 2 of section tenth of chapter second of R. S., 7613 title twelfth of the Revised Statutes, 1909, being articles 7613 to 7629, inclusive, and forms A, B and C which follow article 7629, are repealed. to 7629, etc., repealed.

**2.** This act shall not apply to pending cases. Pending cases.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

## CHAP. 77

An Act to amend articles 210 and 1318 of the Civil Code

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 210 of the Civil Code, as it reads in article C. C., 210, 5788 of the Revised Statutes, 1888, is amended: am.

*a.* by replacing the words: "she requires the authorization of her husband, or, upon his refusal, that of a judge" in the fourth, fifth and sixth lines thereof, by the words: "she requires the authorization of a judge";

*b.* by adding thereto the following paragraph:
