An Act to amend the charter of *L'Union Saint-Joseph à Saint-Roch de Québec*

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

WHEREAS *L'Union Saint-Joseph à Saint-Roch de Québec*, has, by its petition, represented: Preamble.

That since its incorporation by the act 44-45 Victoria, chapter 52, and amendments made thereto by the act 6 George V, chapter 84, the said society has believed it to be necessary for its material progress, and advantageous for its members, to pay the funeral benefits in the event of the predecease of the wives of the members;

That the powers granted to the said society by the above cited acts do not authorize the payment of such benefits;

That the said society deems it to be in the interest and to the advantage of its members that it be authorized to grant such benefits;

And whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

“5. The object of the said corporation is to form among Objects of
the cor-
poration.
the French-speaking Catholics of both sexes of St-Roch de Québec and neighborhood, a provident and mutual benefit society, for the purpose of providing its members, by means of the revenue derived from the property of the society and the contributions of its members, with assistance in case of illness or accident, and in the event of death, of paying their funeral expenses and giving assistance to their heirs and to pay the funeral expenses in the event of the wife of any of the members predeceasing such member. These latter benefits are not subject to the *proviso* of paragraph 3 of section 8 of the act 44-45 Victoria, chapter 52, as enacted by the act 6 George V, chapter 84, section 3.”
