An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Joseph Ernest Grégoire amongst its members after an oral examination

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

WHEREAS Joseph Ernest Grégoire, notary, of the city of Quebec, has, by his petition, represented: Preamble.

That he is a licentiate in law of Laval University of Quebec, and was admitted to the practice of the notarial profession on the 14th of July, 1912, after a regular clerkship and having successfully passed his examinations before the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec;

That he wishes to cease practising that profession and to be admitted to the practice of law;

That he was regularly admitted to study the legal profession;

That he was indentured to Mr. Lucien Moreau, advocate, in the city of Quebec;

That, on the 23rd of October, 1919, the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec gave its approval to the passing of this act;

And whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed for the aforesaid purposes, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to dispense the said Joseph Ernest Grégoire from continuing his clerkship, and to admit him among its members and to allow him to practise the legal profession immediately after an oral examination only. Bar authorized to admit J. E. Grégoire to practise after oral examination.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
