CHAP. 164

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Charles Montminy to the practice of law, after examination

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

WHEREAS Charles Montminy, law student, has by petition represented:

That he is a British subject by birth, having been born in Quebec, on the 5th day of May, 1891;

That he followed the classical course of the Quebec Seminary;

That he followed the courses of Laval University for three years;

That he studied under indenture in the office of Mr. G. G. Stuart, advocate, of Quebec, counting from November, 1910;

That he was admitted to the study of law, in sciences, on the 9th of July, 1914;

That he had, on the 5th day of July, 1915, given his notice and made his deposit for the purpose of completing his examination for admission to the study of law by undergoing the examination in letters, but he was prevented from doing so in July, 1915, because he was called to military service on the 21st of June, 1915, upon his voluntary enlistment in His Majesty's troops for the war just ended;

That he completed his regular admission to the study of law by successfully passing the examination in letters on the 8th of July, 1919;

That on account of his military service overseas he cannot present himself for the examination for admission to the practice of law until July, 1922, which will make him lose considerable time and cause him irreparable damage;

That the General Council of the Bar of the Province of

Quebec has approved the passing of an act to allow the petitioner to be admitted to practice immediately after successfully undergoing the regular and ordinary examination;

Whereas the said Charles Montminy has prayed for the passing of an act for the aforesaid purposes, and it is expedient to grant the request to that effect contained in the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Bar authorized to admit C. Montminy to practise after examination. Coming into force.

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit Charles Montminy to the practice of law immediately after the regular and ordinary examination for admission to the practice of the legal profession.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 165

An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Z. Armour Côté to the practice of dentistry

[Assented to, 14th of February, 1920]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Z. Armour Côté, of the city and district of Montreal, doctor of dental surgery, was admitted to follow, and has followed a complete course of clinical studies in dentistry at the school of Dental Surgery of Laval University at Montreal, where, after a regular examination, he graduated and received the diploma of doctor of dental surgery on the 3rd May 1918;

Whereas, through such studies and his experience, the has acquired the knowledge and title required for practising dental surgery and the necessary competence for the exercise of that profession;

Whereas, since he obtained the said diploma of doctor of dental surgery, he has been prevented from undergoing the examination before the Board of Governors of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec for practising the profession of dentistry because he completed only on the 10th September 1919, his examination for admission to the study of that profession, but was regularly admitted at that date, after having previously
