

than five hundred dollars, recoverable before any magistrate having jurisdiction, in the ordinary manner, and, on failure to pay the fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than three months."

## CHAP. 34

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting public instruction

[Assented to, 17th of March, 1919]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The French version of article 2590 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by replacing the words: "Ne peuvent concerner", in the second line thereof, by the words: "peuvent ne concerner". <sup>R.S., 2590, am. in French version.</sup>

**2.** Article 2668b of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted by the act 4 George V, chapter 24, section 1, is amended by replacing the words: "this day", in the fourth line thereof, by the words: "the day on which the nominations shall so take place". <sup>Id., 2668b, am.</sup>

**3.** Article 2702 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by replacing the words: "Two commissioners", at the beginning of the first line thereof, by the words: "The school inspector, two commissioners,". <sup>Id., 2702, am.</sup>

**4.** Article 2718 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by replacing the word: "May", in the third line thereof, by the word: "June". <sup>Id., 2718, am.</sup>

**5.** Article 2995 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by the act 5 George V, chapter 36, section 15, is further amended by replacing the last two paragraphs thereof by the following:

"With the authorization of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, a Normal school professor or a school inspector appointed as a member of the civil service may transfer to the civil service pension fund the amounts retained and <sup>Certain officials may transfer to civil service pension fund</sup>

**"3037.** No pensioner shall receive his semi-annual payment unless he applies therefor by a declaration under oath before a justice of the peace, a notary or a Commissioner of the Superior Court, stating that he is entitled thereto. Such declaration must be transmitted to the Superintendent of Public Instruction during the first fifteen days of the months of June and December."
