C H A P. 35

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, relating
to public instruction

[Assented to, 17th of March, 1919]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 2768 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by the act 7 George V, chapter 27, section 5, is further amended:

a. by replacing the words: "September and the first day of October", in the second line thereof, by the words: "January and the first day of February";

b. by adding thereto the following paragraph:

"If the secretary does not make such census at the said date, the superintendent shall have it made at the expense of the school municipality."

2. The following article is inserted in the Revised Statutes, 1909, after article 2768 thereof, as amended by the act 7 George V, chapter 27, section 5: R.S., 2768a, enacted.

"**2768a.** Notwithstanding the provisions of article 2768, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may order that a census of the children of one or more school municipalities included wholly or in part within a city or town municipality, be taken in such a manner, upon such conditions, at such time and in such places as may be deemed advisable." Census of children in certain school municipalities may be ordered.

3. Article 2931 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by the acts 3 George V, chapter 23, section 2; 3 George V, chapter 25, section 2; 7 George V, chapter 27, section 8, is again amended by inserting therein the following paragraph: Id., 2931, am.

"6. That a statistical report, according to a form approved by the Superintendent of Public Instruction, attested under oath and signed by the majority of the commissioners or trustees, as the case may be, and by the secretary-treasurer, has been sent to the school inspector previous to the fifteenth of July of each year. If the said report is not sent to the inspector, the latter may proceed to the office of the secretary-treasurer during the following month of August, to obtain the school statistics; and the expenses incurred by the inspector shall be paid by the school corporation in default."
