An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting
the summoning of jurors

[Assented to, 17th of March, 1919]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., 3442,
am. **1.** Article 3442 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended
by inserting therein, after the first paragraph thereof, the
following paragraph:

Days for
which jurors
shall be
summoned. "The grand jurors shall be summoned for the opening
day of the term, and the petit jurors for the next day.
Nevertheless, the Attorney-General may, if he thinks fit,
in the interest of the good administration of justice, order
the summoning of the grand or petit jurors for another
date, fixed by the authorization which he will forward to
the clerk of the Crown or clerk of the peace, in accor-
dance with the foregoing provisions, and, in such case,
the clerk of the Crown or the clerk of the peace shall
give instructions to the sheriff to summon the grand or
petit jurors for the date so fixed."

am. **2.** Article 3452 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amend-
ed:

a. By replacing the word: "thirty", in the first line
thereof, by the word: "fifty";

b. By replacing the word: "twenty", in the second line
thereof, by the word: "thirty-five".

Coming into
force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its
sanction.
