

## C H A P. 52

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting  
lunatic asylums

[Assented to, 17th of March, 1919]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of  
Quebec, enacts as follows:

R.S., 4093,  
amended.

**1.** Article 4093 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by inserting therein, after the word: "clothing", in the seventh line thereof, the word: "work".

**2.** The following article is inserted in the Revised Statutes, 1909, after article 4093:

Proceeds  
of work  
of patients.

**"4093a.** When the medical superintendent believes that it will benefit the health of a patient to have him employed at such manual labour as his condition permits, the proceeds of the sale of the result of such work, if any, shall be paid over to the Provincial Treasurer to form part of the fund for the support of the insane."

**3.** Article 4105 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by striking out paragraph 2 thereof.

**4.** The provisions of section 3 shall apply to all lunatics who are public patients in confinement since the 1st of January, 1919.

**5.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
