An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting
the erection of monuments to soldiers who died
during the war

[Assented to, 17th of March, 1919]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R.S., 5956zb.
enacted.

1. Chapter second of title eleventh of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by adding thereto, after section twenty-fourth (articles 5956u to 5956za), as enacted by the act 9 George V, chapter 61, section 1, the following section and articles:

“SECTION XXV

“ERECTION OF MONUMENTS TO SOLDIERS WHO DIED DURING
THE WAR OF 1914-1919

“**5956zb.** The council of any municipality, however incorporated and by whatever law governed, may pass a by-law to provide for the erection in the municipality of a monument to the memory of the Canadian soldiers who died during the present war (1914-1919), and for the borrowing of the amount of money required therefor.

Provisions
to apply.

Such by-law, when it provides for a loan, shall be subject to the provisions of the act 8 George V, chapter 60, in the case of municipalities coming within the purview of that act, except that the loan may be made repayable at a term of forty years.”

Coming into
force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
