

## C H A P. 80

An Act to amend article 749 of the Code of Civil Procedure  
relating to the deposits required in certain cases of  
sales by the Sheriff

[Assented to, 17th of March, 1919]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

C. C. P., 749,  
amended.     **1.** Article 749 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended  
by the act 1 George V (1st session), chapter 42, section 6,  
is further amended by inserting therein, after the word:  
“cases”, in the fifth line thereof, the words: “or in  
any other case deemed necessary,”.

Coming into  
force.     **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its  
sanction.

C H A P. 81

An Act to amend article 786 of the Code of Civil Procedure  
respecting the delay for presentation of the petition  
to vacate sheriff's sales

[Assented to, 17th of March, 1919]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

C. C. P.,  
art. 786,  
replaced.     **1.** Article 786 of the Code of Civil Procedure is replaced  
by the following:

Delay.

“**786.** Applications under article 784 to vacate sheriff's  
sales, must be made within a delay of three months.”

Coming into  
force.     **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its  
sanction.
