An Act to amend article 403 of the Quebec Municipal Code

[Assented to, 17th of March, 1919]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 403 of the Quebec Municipal Code is amended Q. M. C., by adding thereto, at the end thereof, the following para-art. 403, am. graph:

“5. To order that, throughout the whole or part of the ^{Early} year, every store, shop, stall or other place of one or the ^{closing.} other class where any local business is carried on shall be closed and remain closed, on each day or any day of the week, after the times and hours fixed and determined therefor by the by-laws; but the times and hours so fixed and determined shall never be later than seven o'clock in the morning nor earlier than seven o'clock in the evening”.

An Act to amend article 429 of the Quebec Municipal Code respecting vehicular traffic in winter

[Assented to, 17th of March, 1919]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 429 of the Quebec Municipal Code is amended Q. M. C., by adding thereto the following paragraph: art. 429, am.

“3. To oblige every person driving any vehicle, in winter, ^{Sleigh-bells,} to attach to the horse or vehicle a bell or bells or other &c. device of a similar nature to warn pedestrians of the approach of such vehicle”.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. force.
