given to the corporation in section 7 hereof, the Boys' Farm and Training School shall own, hold and administer generally all assets which may be conveyed to it by any person, or may be set apart or appropriated for the use or purposes of the said Boys' Farm and Training School or any other training, industrial or reformatory school which may be established by the said corporation. The said Boys' Farm and Training School may enter into any contract or contracts which may be necessary for the establishment or the administration of such training, industrial or reformatory schools as may be carried on by it.

14. Nothing in this act shall have the effect of withdrawing the corporation from being governed by the provisions of the charter, by-laws and regulations of any municipality where the said corporation may exercise its powers, nor by the provisions of the Quebec Public Health Act.

15. The corporation shall, every year, transmit to the Lieutenant-Governor in council a detailed statement of its property, a copy of its rules and by-laws and a list of its officers.

CHAP. 133

An Act respecting the Trafalgar Institute

[Assented to, 4th of March, 1919]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Trafalgar Institute has by its petition represented:

That by the act 35 Victoria, chapter 43, the said Trafalgar Institute was incorporated for the purposes in said act stated;

That among other things, it was provided in said act of incorporation, that,—Donald Ross, Esquire, of the parish of Montreal, in the Province of Quebec, and such successor or successors to the said Donald Ross as may be appointed and nominated as such, from time to time, by the Board of Trustees of St. Paul's Church from amongst the members of such Board; the Rev. John Jenkins, D.D., minister of the Church of Scotland in Montreal aforesaid called and known as "St. Paul's Church" and his successors, ministers of said St. Paul's Church; the Rev. Gavin Lang, minister

of the Church of Scotland in Montreal, aforesaid, called and known as "St. Andrew's Church", and his successors, ministers of the said St. Andrew's Church; Alexander Mitchell, of Montreal aforesaid, merchant, and such successor and successors of the said Alexander Mitchell as may be appointed and nominated as such from time to time by the Kirk Session of said St. Andrew's Church from amongst their members, and Alexander Macpherson of Montreal, aforesaid, merchant, and such successor and successors to the said Alexander Macpherson as may be appointed and nominated as such from time to time by the Kirk Session of said St. Paul's Church from amongst their members, should, as representing the said two churches of St. Andrew's and St. Paul's, with others named in said act, be entrusted with the management of the affairs of the said Trafalgar Institute;

That the said Trafalgar Institute, after its incorporation, commenced, and has ever since carried on the work for which it was incorporated, and the above mentioned persons and their successors have ever since formed part of the board of governors of the said Trafalgar Institute, and are now represented as follows: Baron Atholstan of the city of Montreal, a peer of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, nominated by the board of trustees of St. Paul's Church; the Rev. George Duncan, minister of St. Andrew's Church; Farquhar Robertson, esquire, of Montreal, merchant, appointed and nominated by the Kirk Session of St. Andrew's Church, and the Honourable John S. Archibald, Acting Chief Justice of the Superior Court for the Province of Quebec at Montreal, appointed and nominated by the Kirk Session of St. Paul's Church;

That the said churches of St. Andrew's and St. Paul's have ceased to be in connection with the Church of Scotland, and have become connected with, and now form part of the Presbyterian Church in Canada, and are now duly authorized by competent authority to exercise their rights of representation on the board of governors of said Trafalgar Institute, to the same extent as was contemplated by the original act of incorporation of said Trafalgar Institute;

That said two churches of St. Andrew's and St. Paul's have been, by mutual consent and under the authority of the Presbyterian Church in Canada, united into one church or congregation, under the name of "The Church of St. Andrew and St. Paul".

That by the union of St. Andrew's and St. Paul's churches aforesaid, there remains only one minister of the two churches, and the representation of said two churches upon the board of governors of said Trafalgar Institute is now

composed of four members instead of five, as provided by the original act of incorporation;

That it is expedient that the representation of said two churches on the board of governors of the Trafalgar Institute should be continued at five members, as contemplated by the act of incorporation;

That by the union of the said two churches the board of trustees of St. Paul's Church has since said union ceased to exist, and the secular affairs of the said united church are now managed by a board of trustees;

That the said petitioners pray that their said act of incorporation, as amended, be further amended as hereinafter mentioned;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of said petition:

Therefore His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Certain acts ratified. **1.** All acts mentioned in the preamble which may have been done by the members of the present governing board of the Trafalgar Institute, or any of them, in and about the governing of the affairs of the said Trafalgar Institute since the union of the said two churches of St. Andrew's and St. Paul's, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Representation of church of St. Andrew and St. Paul on governing board. **2.** The representation of the said Church of St. Andrew and St. Paul on the governing board of the said Trafalgar Institute shall be: the Reverend George Duncan, minister of the Church of St. Andrew and St. Paul, and his successor or successors in that office; Baron Atholstan of the city of Montreal, a peer of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, being a member of the board of trustees of the said Church of St. Andrew and St. Paul, and such successor or successors in his said office as shall be nominated and appointed by said board from among its members; The Honourable John S. Archibald, Acting Chief Justice of the Superior Court, and Farquhar Robertson, merchant, both of the city of Montreal and members of the Kirk Session of the Church of St. Andrew and St. Paul, and their successor or successors who shall be nominated and appointed for that purpose by such Kirk Session from among its members; and such person as the said Kirk Session shall nominate and appoint to fill the vacancy arising from the reduction of the ministerial representations from two to one, and his successor or successors appointed in like manner.

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
