

C H A P . 5

An Act respecting certain contracts in connection with the maintenance, lodging and treatment of the insane

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

WHEREAS, owing to the increased cost of necessaries Preamble.
of all kinds, it is expedient to raise to a higher rate than that stipulated in their respective contracts with the Government, the price per head for the maintenance, lodging and treatment of the insane in each of the asylums mentioned below;

Therefore His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding all the provisions contained in Certain the contracts ratified, authorized or amended by the acts contracts enumerated in the schedule to this act, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may enter into a contract with each of the corporations hereinafter mentioned for increasing from the first of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen to the expiration of their present respective contracts, the total yearly price per head for the maintenance, lodging and treatment of the insane in their asylums to an amount not exceeding that mentioned opposite their names in the following table, namely:

The Sisters of Charity of Providence, for their Longue Pointe Asylum.....	\$ 200.00
The Sisters of Charity of Quebec, for their Beauport Asylum.....	200.00
The Protestant hospital for the insane, for the Verdun asylum.....	200.00
The Sisters of Charity of Quebec for their St. Ferdinand de Halifax asylum.....	150.00
The <i>Institut des Petites Sœurs Franciscaines de Marie</i> for their asylum at St. Anne de la Baie St. Paul.....	150.00

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into sanction. force.
