An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting
the protection of plants from destructive insects and
fungoid diseases

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 2041*l* of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted R. S. 2041*l*,
by the act 4 George V, chapter 17, section 1, is amended: ^{am.}

a. By adding at the end of the first enumeration of
destructive insects and plant diseases, the following figures
and names:

“8. European currant rust.

“9. White pine blister rust.”;

b. By adding after the second enumeration of destructive
insects and plant diseases, entitled: “Scientific Names”,
the following figures and names:

“8. *Cronartium ribicola*, Fisch.

“9. *Peridermium Strobi*, Kleb.”; and

c. By adding thereto the following paragraph:

“The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may extend the Application
application of this section to other destructive insects and ^{may be ex-}
other plant diseases not included in the above list, when tended.
circumstances require, and for a specified period.”
