

for any subsequent offence, to a fine of not less than two hundred dollars nor more than five hundred dollars, and, on failure to pay the same, to imprisonment for not more than six months.

Article not to apply in certain cases.

This article shall not apply to any engineer who, prior to December 31st, 1917, was a corporate member of any recognized society of Civil Engineers, and had been practising the profession in the Province of Quebec during the four years prior to said date."

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 58

An Act to amend article 5247 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting architects

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., 5247, am.

1. Article 5247 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as replaced by the act 7 George V, chapter 39, section 2, is amended by replacing the words: "No person, except an architect or landscape architect," in the first and second lines thereof, by the words: "No person, unless he is a landscape architect,".

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 59

An Act relating to the maintenance of winter roads on provincial roads

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Definition.

1. In this act the expression "provincial road" or "provincial roads" means a road built by the Government
