CHAP. 58

An Act to amend article 5247 of the Revised Statutes, 1909,
respecting architects

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 5247 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as replaced by the act 7 George V, chapter 39, section 2, is amended by replacing the words: "No person, except an architect or landscape architect," in the first and second lines thereof, by the words: "No person, unless he is a landscape architect,".

CHAP. 59

An Act relating to the maintenance of winter roads on
provincial roads

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Definition.

1. In this act the expression "provincial road" or "provincial roads" means a road built by the Government

of this Province under section 19 of the act 3 George V, chapter 21, as well as the King Edward VII road connecting Montreal and Rouse's Point.

2. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, and especially section 2 of the act 7 George V, chapter 10, the maintenance of winter roads on provincial roads shall, as on any other municipal road, be under the control and management of the councils of the municipalities within whose boundaries such roads are situated, and shall be at the charge of the municipal corporations or of the persons by them designated, in conformity with the provisions of the Quebec Municipal Code and the special legislative provisions governing such municipalities. Winter roads to be at charge of municipalities.

3. Balizes must not be placed on the paved part of a provincial road. Placing of balizes.

Every person who places balizes in contravention of this prohibition shall be liable to a fine of not more than eight dollars, and may also be condemned to pay the damages he has caused. Penalty.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

CHAP. 60

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, the Revised Statutes, 1888, and the Quebec Municipal Code respecting municipal affairs

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Chapter second of title eleventh of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by adding thereto, after section XXIIb (articles 5956c to 5956h), as enacted by the act 6 George V, chapter 30, section 1, the following sections and articles: R. S., 5956i, et seq., enacted.
