An Act to amend the Civil Code relating to the investment
of moneys belonging to other persons

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The English version of article 981^o of the Civil Code, C. C., 981^o,
as it reads in article 5803 of the Revised Statutes, 1888, ^{am. as to}
and as amended by the act 7 Edward VII, chapter 54, ^{Eng. vers-}
section 1, is further amended by inserting therein, after ^{ion.}
the word: "stock", in the thirteenth line thereof, the words:
"or debentures".

C H A P . 74

An Act to amend articles 1220 and 2144 of the Civil Code
with regard to certain writings executed out of the
Province of Quebec

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1220 of the Civil Code, as amended by the C. C., art.
acts 62 Victoria, chapter 49, section 1, 9 Edward VII, ^{1220, am.}
chapter 70, section 1, 3 George V, chapter 47, section 1, and
7 George V, chapter 51, section 1, is again amended by
inserting therein, in paragraph 5 thereof, after the words
added by the act 7 George V, chapter 51, section 1, the
words: "before the Canadian Commissioner in France,
for the French Republic, before the Agent General of the
Province in Belgium, for the Kingdom of Belgium, or".

2. Article 2144 of the Civil Code is amended by adding ^{C. C., art.}
thereto a new paragraph, as follows: ^{2144, am.}

"If it be executed in France, the affidavit may also be
sworn to by the Canadian Commissioner in the French

Republic, and, if it be executed in Belgium, before the Agent-General of the Province in the Kingdom of Belgium.”

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 75

An Act to amend article 1994 of the Civil Code

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

C. C., art. 1994, am. **1.** Paragraph 9 of article 1994 of the Civil Code, as contained in article 5825 of the Revised Statutes, 1888, and as amended by the act 59 Victoria, chapter 41, section 1, is replaced by the following:

“9. Servants’ wages and those of employees of railway companies engaged in manual labor, sums due under article 7340 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, and sums due for supplies of provisions.”

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 76

An Act to amend articles 2161 and 2162 of the Civil Code relating to the keeping of certain registers in registry offices

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

C. C., art. 2161, am. **1.** Article 2161 of the Civil Code, as amended by the acts 2 Edward VII, chapter 39, section 1, and 3 George V, chapter 48, section 1, is again amended by replacing paragraph 3 thereof by the following:

Contents of entry-book. “3. An entry-book in which are entered the year,
