An Act to amend article 35 of the Quebec Municipal Code

[Assented to 9th February, 1918]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 35 of the Quebec Municipal Code is amended:

a. By striking out the words: "and, in short, alter the boundaries of those already existing", at the end of the first paragraph thereof;

b. By replacing the second paragraph thereof by the following:

Conditions
on which
alteration of
boundaries
may be
granted.

"Any alteration under this article may be granted on the following conditions:

If it is applied for by the majority of the owners of immoveable property within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be erected into a new municipality, or to be annexed to an existing municipality.

In the case of the division or dismemberment of a municipality, if such division or dismemberment is applied for by the majority of the owners of immoveable property in the municipality.

Provided that after such an erection, annexation, division or dismemberment, each municipality shall preserve the population or the number of inhabited houses required by article 36 or 37, as the case may be."

Coming into
force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
