## CHAP. 6

An Act to amend the act 2 George V, chapter 2, relating to toll bridges and turnpike roads in the Province

[Assented to 22nd December, 1916]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

2 Geo. V, c. 2, s. 2, am. **1.** Section 2 of the act 2 George V, chapter 2, is amended by replacing the word: "five", in the first line thereof, by the word: "eight."

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

## CHAP. 7

An Act respecting the redemption of tolls on the Saint Constant and Laprairie Road

[Assented to 22nd December, 1916]

Preamble. **W**HEREAS there are still toll-gates on the road from Saint Constant to Laprairie at which tolls are charged;

And whereas it is expedient to abolish them as in other parts of the Province;

Therefore His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Certain toll-gates and tolls abolished. **1.** The toll-gates and tolls on the Saint Constant and Laprairie road on a length of about seven miles, in the parishes of Saint Constant and Laprairie and in the town of Laprairie, are hereby abolished.

**2.** The owner of the said road, Madame Brosseau, shall be paid an amount of \$19,250.00, being the value of the said road established on the 16th December, 1916, by Alexandre Larivière, engineer of the roads Department of this Province, as commutation of all her rights in the said road, but all other property, such as gates, houses, lots, machines or stone, shall remain the property of the said Madame Brosseau. Amount payable to owner.

**3.** The Government shall pay \$14,437.50 of the said amount of \$19,250.00, and the balance of \$4,812.50 shall be paid by the municipalities mentioned below. By whom payable.

**4.** All amounts to be paid by the Government under this act shall be taken out of the moneys voted by the act 2 George V, chapter 2. Fund affected.

**5.** The said amount of \$4,812.50, shall be paid as follows: Apportionment among municipalities.

The parish of Laprairie.....	\$1,500.00
The town of Laprairie.....	600.00
The parish of Saint Constant.....	1,500.00
The parish of Saint-Remi.....	500.00
The town of Saint-Rémi.....	212.50
The parish of Saint-Isidore.....	100.00
The parish of Saint-Edouard.....	150.00
The parish of Saint-Michel.....	250.00

**6.** Upon a proclamation by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, after the Government shall have paid the share it has to contribute, the said Madame Brosseau shall cease to charge tolls, and shall remove the gates; and the said road shall become the property of and be under the control respectively of each of the municipalities within the boundaries of which such road is situated. Tolls not to be charged after proclamation.

**7.** Failing the payment by any of such municipalities of the share it is respectively bound to pay within the fifteen days following the proclamation mentioned in section 6 of this act, the said Madame Brosseau may recover the same by ordinary suit before any court of competent jurisdiction. Recourse against municipalities.

**8.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
