An Act to insert article 1627*a* in the Revised Statutes, 1909

[Assented to 22nd December, 1916]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Revised Statutes, 1909, are amended by insert- R. S., 1627*a*,
ing therein, after article 1627, the following article, to wit: enacted.

“**1627*a***. During any other season, the holders of timber Other than
limits may haul lumber and provisions across the property winter
of persons holding lands within their limits; provided that season.
they shall be bound, as by article 1627, to indemnify the
owners for any damage caused by them or by their em-
ployees.”

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, relating to

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 2031*b* of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as R. S., 2031*b*,
enacted by the act 1 George V (1st session), chapter 16, am.
section 1, and amended by the act 5 George V, chapter 31,
section 9, is again amended:

a. By replacing paragraph 2 thereof by the following:

“2. The words “butter factory” mean any establish- “Butter

where.”;

b. By striking out the word “cheddar” in the third line
of paragraph 3 thereof.
