

C H A P. 56

An Act to amend article 1249 of the Code of Civil Procedure relating to procedure in giving security in case of an appeal to His Majesty

[Assented to 22nd December, 1916]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1249 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended: C. C. P., art. 1249, am.

a. By replacing the words: "one of the judges", in the first line of the second paragraph thereof, by the words: "the clerk";

b. By replacing the word: "judge" in the first line of the fifth paragraph thereof, by the word: "clerk";

c. By replacing the word: "judge" in the last line of the said article, by the word: "clerk".

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

C H A P. 57

An Act to amend the act 6 George V, chapter 4

[Assented to 22nd December, 1916]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The following paragraphs are added to section 7 of the act 6 George V, chapter 4, to wit: 6 Geo. V, c. 4, s. 7, am.

"Nevertheless, article 1082 of the old Municipal Code, as enacted, as a special provision, by the act 34 Victoria, chapter 68, with regard to the council of the municipality of the parish of St. Romuald d'Etchemin, shall remain in force, and the said municipality shall possess all the powers conferred on the council of a village municipality, in addition to those of the council of a parish municipality. Art. 1082 of old Municipal Code to remain in force.

The five present wards of the municipality are preserved, but the council may, by by-law, change them, or divide Provision as to wards in

St. Romuald d'Etchemin. the municipality into as many wards as it deems advisable, provided such number shall not be more than the number of councillors to be elected; it may also divide the said municipality into polling-districts and appoint therefor the necessary election officers. Nevertheless, the mayor shall be elected by the vote of the electors in all the wards."

Provision for reduction of councillors. **2.** In order to reduce the present number of councillors to six, the council may by resolution decide which of the wards shall elect only one councillor.

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P. 58

An Act relating to the interpretation of the Municipal Code

[Assented to 22nd December, 1916]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Any matter requiring approval of Lt. Gov. in C. under old Mun. Code, may receive such approval. **1.** Any transaction, matter or thing commenced under the Municipal Code which came into force on the 2nd of November, 1871, and which, to be complete and effective, lacked, on the first of November, 1916, the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor or of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, may receive such approval, despite the repeal of the said code, and every such transaction, matter or thing so approved, shall have the same value and effect as if the said code had not been repealed.

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
