An Act to amend the charter of the town of Hampstead

[Assented to 22nd December, 1916]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the town of Hampstead has by its petition represented that it was incorporated by the act 4 George V, chapter 94;

Whereas since the date of the said incorporation a limited number of persons have become actual residents within the limits of the municipality;

Whereas it is desirable to further provide for the administration of the town, and the said town of Hampstead has prayed that its charter be amended in the manner hereinafter mentioned; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

4 Geo. V, c. 94, s. 8, replaced.

1. Section 8 of the act 4 George V, chapter 94, is replaced by the following:

R. S., 5363, par. 8, replaced for the town. Disqualification.

“**8.** Paragraph 8 of article 5363 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is replaced for the town, by the following:

“8. Whosoever has had no residence or principal place of business in the municipality for at least twelve months previous to the election or nomination.

Exception.

Nevertheless during the six first years following the date of the coming into force of this act (6th of February, 1914), the above provision shall not apply to the town, and the mayor and aldermen may be residents of a neighboring municipality.”

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
