An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit George H. Shink to the practice of law, after examination

[Assented to 22nd December, 1916]

Preamble.

WHEREAS George H. Shink, student at law, has, by his petition, represented:

That he has followed a complete course of classical studies, and obtained the degree of Bachelor of Arts from Laval University in Quebec, in June, 1913;

That he followed the law course of Laval University in Quebec, and passed all the examinations from September, 1913, to June, 1916;

That he was admitted to the study of law by the Bar of the Province, only a year and a half after he entered the university, and, consequently, his admission to practice will be delayed by so much;

That he intends to present himself at the license examinations at Laval University in December, 1916, and at the examinations for admission to practice in January, 1917;

That, at a meeting of the Bar of the Province of Quebec, held on the 29th of October 1915, a resolution was passed approving the passing of an act allowing the petitioner to be admitted to practice immediately after passing the required examination;

Whereas the said George H. Shink has prayed for the passing of an act for the purposes aforesaid, and it is expedient to grant the prayer to that effect contained in the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Bar authorized to permit G. H. Shink to practise immediately. Coming into force.

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to permit George H. Shink to practise law immediately after passing the required examination.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
