

C H A P . 23

An Act to authorize school commissions to make contributions from their funds for patriotic, national or school purposes.

[Assented to 16th March, 1916]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

School commissions may contribute for certain purposes.

1. Any school commission may contribute, out of the funds of the commission not otherwise appropriated, and up to six per cent of its gross revenue, by resolution, to funds opened by corporations or persons for public subscription for patriotic, national or school purposes within the Province or elsewhere.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P . 24

An Act to amend article 3408 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, and to exempt practising civil engineers from serving as jurors.

[Assented to 16th March, 1916]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R.S., 3408, am.

1. Article 3408 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by the act 5 George V, chapter 54, section 1, is again amended by inserting therein, after paragraph 8a thereof, a new paragraph, 8b, as follows:

Civil engineers.

“8b. Practising civil engineers;”.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
